StuttCard

Presentation of the attractive StuttCard guarantees free admission and other advantages at more than 50 partner institutions in the Stuttgart Region – including all of Stuttgart's museums and many leisure facilities. Art lovers can enjoy the Stuttgart State Gallery (Staatsgalerie Stuttgart), the Stuttgart Museum of Art (Kunstmuseum) and many other galleries in the region, such as the Galerie Stihl in Waiblingen. Automobile enthusiasts will love the unique Mercedes-Benz and Porsche museums. And for those interested in the region's stately homes, there are the former royal palaces of Ludwigsburg and Solitude, or the Royal Burial Chapel. Stuttgart Citytour

Discover Stuttgart on a red, open-top bus: the routes of the hop-on/hop-off buses of the Blue and Green Tours access many of Stuttgart's attractions. The Blue Tour is in operation all year round and lasts around 100 minutes, taking in Stuttgart's most important places of interest – Palace Square, the Mercedes-Benz Museum, the vineyards and the Weissenhof Estate. The **Blue Tour** circuit has nine stopping points. The double-decker buses of the **Green Tour** take you through the south and west of Stuttgart, with eight different stopping points where you can get off and on as you please. The Television Tower, Stuttgart's main landmark, is also part of the Citytour route. The Green Tour is in operation from April to October.

Between spring and autumn the new **Stuttgart Wine Tour** shows you Stuttgart's wonderful vineyard scenery. During the approximately 35-minute tour, wine and nature lovers can get on and off the bus at six stopping points and visit various wineries, the Stuttgart Museum of Viniculture or the Royal Burial Chapel on the Württemberg.

During one of the nicest seasons of the year, guests can enjoy listening to Stuttgart tales of Advent and soak up the atmosphere of yuletide Stuttgart on the entertaining "**Stuttgart Christmas Tour**". This tour is the ideal way to round off a visit to the Christmas Market and the "Stuttgart Highlights".

Stuttgart Tours

Our Stuttgart tours invite visitors to get to know Stuttgart from different angles and immerse themselves in the past and present of Baden-Württemberg's state capital. Ghost tours, gourmet tours, architecture tours or wine tastings – there are around 30 different circular tours and walks on offer between January and December 2021.
